Welcome to Hillsborough Baptist

IF you aim at nothingyou will hit it every time.

Towards the end of last year I felt as though the wind had gone out of my sails when it came to youth ministry. I looked toward 2012, and saw youth ministry as a never ceasing wheel rotation..... In that we do the same thing in the same orderpretty much for the past 6 years. The result of this outlook was that I had a totally **LAME EXPECTATION** for 2012. Fittingly **God totally nailed me.** This slap of conviction over my attitude happened as I read through the early chapters of Luke's Gospel as the story of Elizabeth and Mary unfolded. Appreciating that those stories hold far greater theological significance than what I was nailed with, I was never-the-less assaulted with the reality that GOD is totally okay with the daily God-inspired routines (the youth church calendar would come under this heading) that are formulated to keep us in fellowship and growing in faith. But...and this is what really excited me...it is the abiding in Him in the above ways , that makes open the way for Him to **STUPENDOUSLY** cut across our plans and bring into effect immeasurably greater things than we ever envisaged for our lives (as he did with Elizabeth and Mary). The key is living in a constant state of heart readinessand that is what we work at with our youth.....daily, weekly....throwing them into God.

I'd encourage you to look at your expectations in God for 2012 too – maybe like me – you run the risk of just trudging along with the HBC routine, unconsciously giving little of yourself ...and expecting even less in return. A suggestion: **repent** and give Him your life afresh....daily ...and wait with confident expectation for Him cut across your plans too.

PS Craig is preaching and teaching in Awhi and the youth church from the Gospel of Luke – sometimes a more therapeutic style of preaching with a little scripture weaved in, is what our kids would like. What they need though is pure Jesus. If you have teenage children it would soo help our cause if you poured over the book of Luke too. That would see you journeying with them too.
