 was our 'retreat day' for Elders and staff alike. A

 commissioning service as he seeks to serve the
 Lord in a full time capacity in the life of the
 church. His responsibilities will largely be in the
 area of pastoral care, supporting people's
 ministries like welcoming new folk into the church,
 home groups and preaching etc. We are privileged
 to have both Eamon and Emma on the church
 team and look forward to the impact of their lives
 amongst us.
