During the first two Sunday worship services of the New Year I encouraged you to partner with the Holy Spirit in working out some new year's resolutions that were drawn from Colossians 3:12-17.

I encourage you to pop the list in your bible and each morning prayerfully declare your intention, with God's help, to practice living them out throughout the day.

11 resolutions to practice in 2012

1. To be compassionate. This is the ability to feel what it's like to live inside somebody else's skin.
2. To be kind. I will seek to meet the needs of others through kind deeds.
3. To be humble. True humility is not putting myself down but rather lifting others up. Today, with God's strength, I will not put myself down but instead I will lift up and encourage other people I meet.
4. To be meek. Meekness is power under control. I resolve to live under the control of God's Holy Spirit.
5. To be patient. I will trust that God is in control of the situation/circumstances I am currently facing.
6. To be forgiving. I will forgive others in proportion to how much the Lord has forgiven me.
7. To love. I will continue to love others, even if they don't love me back.
8. To let the peace of God rule my heart. Peace will act as the umpire in all my life decisions.
- 9 To be thankful. I resolve to complain less and be thankful more.
10. To let the word of Christ richly dwell in me.
11. To do all things to the approval of the Lord.

May God richly bless you as you practice living out these wonderful character traits.
