In moments of despair, confusion, uncertainty or darkness, it's only natural to wonder what is happening & where is God? The devastating news in the past few weeks has pressed us all to ask these questions.

This is when we need to cling to a "but God" faith, where we believe things may look bad, but God is working it for good.

We may be hard pressed on every side, but God keeps us from being crushed; perplexed, but God lifts us from the pits of despair; persecuted, but God stands by our side; struck down, but God makes us indestructible by filling us with his incorruptible Spirit. (2 Corinthians 4)
