As an opening thought for today's topic I would like to encourage you to personalise a challenging statement that was given to the Christian author Brennan Manning by his spiritual director. He said "Brennan (personalise this statement with your own name), you don't need any more insights into the faith. You've got enough insights to last you three hundred years. The most urgent need in your life is to trust what you have received."

Do you trust the things you have received from God?

Do you trust the things he's revealed to you about himself through his word?

Do you trust him no matter what is happening, has happened, or will happen in your life?

Do you trust him in the big things, the little things, even the good bad and ugly things that are going on in your life right now?

Trust is the only gift you can give to God. It is also the essence of faith and the foundation upon which a great relationship with God is built. As you come to worship God this morning I encourage you to search your heart and confess any areas in your life where you are struggling to trust Him. Be open to his Spirit ministering to your heart. Allow Him to re-dig the well of faith in that area and let it flow in your life in greater measure than it is already.
