Dan Marshall recently circulated a survey among Hillsborough Youth asking: **Who is your hero?** to which the answer was typically Mum or dad. **Would you want your parents at the youth service?** The typical answer was a passionate **NO**. **Would you want to be friends with your parents on Facebook?** The answer was again, a passionate **NO**. These findings give us an insight into what our kids need to get through this tumultuous time. It highlighted the teenager's need for security and acceptance and good consistent role models which is why good parents make the best heroes. It also showed the need for parents to let their teenage children individuate. That means we need to give them SPACE to develop healthy self-esteem which is why they may not find it cool to look back and see you sitting in the back row, waving at them, or see your face pop up and into their witty/sometimes borderline risqué little Facebook chats. It is not always easy to be what our kids need us to be. We (youth leaders) don't always get it right – possibly like you, we can have a hard time figuring out what is best to help your children grow themselves and in God. That 's why we'd love to talk with you more about stuff we are working on, why we do the stuff we do in Awahi, changes we have or are making to the way things are done and great material we have come across to help you as a family thrive.

If you are a parent of teenagers in our congregation, Raewyn and I would like you to be part of our **Awahi Parent's forums**. We are going to run them on a Sunday night, starting on **October 2**, while youth church is on at 7-8:30pm in the side hall, every six weeks. Our heart in this is to all be working together to see our children grow in God. The plan is to make lots of space to talk together – not at you and then have a pray. Hope you will come.
