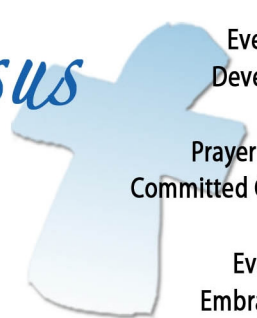

>Welcome to Hillsborough Baptist

What really matters most to us as we gather together to worship at HBC today?

I think the apostle Paul really sums up what really matters in 1 Corinthians 15:3-4 when he wrote "For I handed on to you as of **'first importance'** what I in turn had received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the scriptures,<sup>4</sup> and that he was buried, and that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the scripture."

This is what really matters. Jesus was killed, buried and resurrected. This is why we're here this morning. This is the core of our faith. The cross is what really counts.

For most of us this isn't anything new. You've probably heard about it and thought about it. Most of you believe in it. But is it really of first importance? What would it mean if it was? How different would your life be? What things would change? What new discoveries would you unearth? These are some of the challenges that await us when we wrestle with this question.

Over the next few weeks I want to encourage you to return to the cross and explore the things that are "of first importance" for our faith life, in a series called "What Really Matters." During our time together I'd like to encourage you to open your heart to the Holy Spirit so that you may experience more of the fullness of the work of the cross in your life, and enjoy living in the reality of it.
