Welcome to Hillsborough Baptist

Just this morning I was talking to one of the parents of our teenagers here at our church and in the middle of our conversation they mentioned that church here is the one positive thing in their child's life.

School, friends and other areas are all a current struggle. To be honest, I was amazed at the power of that statement, and very honestly I said to this parent, "That's pretty incredible, it's cool that church has that kind of place for them but it's not like we see miracles and healings every week. What we do seems rather simple and ordinary, primarily we just relate to them." And this parent wisely said, "but isn't it the very ordinary things (like just relating to my child) that truly are miraculous?"

This just "happened" to tie in with a book I was reading as I had my first coffee this morning. The book, *Revisiting Relational Youth Ministry* was essentially saying the same thing as this parent: the miracle is that Jesus is present with us in community, "where two or three come together in my name, there I am with them" (Matthew 18:20).

I am so proud of our youth and our youth leaders, that one person's child is, whether he realises it or not, experiencing the grace of Jesus when he "hangs" with the guys at Awahi. It was a really good reminder to me and caused me to wonder - would people I "hang" with see Jesus in me? Would the people you "hang" with, see Jesus and experience his grace, through time spent with you?"

Every blessing and so appreciate all that God is doing here!
