Welcome to Hillsborough Baptist

I reckon today is a momentous day! We're standing on the brink of the next decade of what God has for us. HBC has been blessed over nearly 60 years with faithful ministry. Just a sample - under Walter Lang in the 70's and early 80's, God taught us about personal holiness, about walking daily with Jesus in the power of the Holy Spirit; under Lindsay Jones in the 90's, God called us to open up, that his Kingdom in suburban Auckland was going international; and in the 2000's under Greg Liston, God called us to grow up, to see how the post-modern spirit has hardened minds and hearts but also made them open to His transforming power if we're willing to break out of our happy, holy, huddle.

Tomorrow Glenn Edmonds takes up the senior pastor role bringing with him the stirrings of a vision of what it means to be part of God's kingdom. And in multiple areas in the daily life of HBC we sense God calling us into a deeper engagement with what He is doing, rather than what we think needs doing. In that sense I think Alan's parting words to us last week - let's pray to see with the eyes of God - were truly prophetic.

In preparation for Glenn's arrival, the leadership team have been taking stock - you will hear more of Setting your Church Free, you've heard from the Embracing the Neglected team, and you will be hearing more from our Community Trust. This week exec, elders and staff meet to agree on what to recommend as the next steps with our buildings. And we have some challenges too - Stuart Turner and I will talk to one of those as we meet this morning.

It's an exciting time to be at HBC. As elders we sense God asking "Will you join me in what I am doing and intend to do?" Our response has been "Bring it on Lord". I trust that's yours too.
